FAQs for TASS Leisure Sails What the Crew Wants to Know and How to Prepare

Welcome! We aim to provide a positive sailing with TASS Start Living the Life You Imagined!

Often, we are asked by new members or first-time sailing guests what they should bring or how they should prepare for a sail with TASS.

Below are "SUGGESTIONS," which will help you prepare and make your sail a more comfortable experience.

Safety First, therefore, at the time of registration, you are asked to provide a valid email address and phone contact for yourself and any guest for whom you register. Each member and guest must also provide a <u>valid emergency contact person</u>. Changes and updates happen as the weather is unpredictable, and we must be able to contact registrants.

What to Wear or Bring – [recommendations but not requirements]

- Comfortable clothing and soft-soled, non-marking shoes
- Sun protection (hat, sunglass, sunscreen)
- Good idea to have a "croakie" for your sunglasses and a "hat keeper" to attach
 your hat to your shirt #1 & 2 most lost overboard items hats and sunglasses
- Some people prefer a light, long-sleeve shirt for sun protection
- Light jacket in case of rain or unexpected cool breezes [water resistant is good].
- Sailing gear that you already may own (e.g., gloves). There is no need to buy anything; it's nice to have.
- Small SOFT SIDED cooler easy to stow on the boat and does not damage the boat.
- Hydration is important any day on the water, so a sufficient amount of water or sports drinks.

Life jackets, etc., will be on the boat – feel free to bring your own, not necessary to buy one.

Typically, the crew will bring snacks to share: chips, dip, finger food, fruit, etc. This can be discussed with the skipper in command when he/she calls you the day before the sail.

Spare change of clothes & towel/toiletries:

If you would like to take a shower after the sail, you are welcome to do so. The marina has nice, clean showers.

Register and Pay

Remember, you must be **registered at the TASS website**, **www.sailtass.com**, **and pay in full** to sail before boarding.

Acknowledgments through any social media other than the TASS website registration for the event [sail] **do not** constitute registration to any event.

Non-members of TASS [GUEST] are always welcome to join our sails.

About your Skipper of the Day

The name of your Skipper in charge of the sail is listed on the calendar website where you register. Additionally, on the TASS website, we provide the skipper's contact and bio so you can get to know the skipper before you sail. The skipper in command for your sail is always your FIRST contact pre-post sailing. Please use the contact list to find the skipper information. **Contact** TASS Skippers.

When you register, you will receive an email confirmation.

The day before your sail, you will be contacted by your Skipper in Command for the sail. He/She will confirm the meeting time and location and answer any of your questions. Note the time on the website is generic; times may vary slightly as weather conditions are monitored and adjusted accordingly.
